This includes numerous IHC stains specific for diagnosing dermatology specimens, such as HMB-45; MART-1; S-100; SOX-10, Spirochetes, HSV types I and II, HHV-8, and PRAME to distinguish benign from malignant melanocytic lesions.
- Michel's media and processing for Direct Immunofluorescence (DIF) staining. All Oculus dermatopathologists are experienced in the interpretation of DIF stains for immunobullous diseases, lichen planus, lupus, vasculitis, and other connective tissue diseases.
