This includes numerous IHC stains specific for diagnosing dermatology specimens, such as HMB-45; MART-1; S-100; SOX-10, Spirochetes, HSV types I and II, HHV-8, and PRAME to distinguish benign from malignant melanocytic lesions.
- Michel's media and processing for Direct Immunofluorescence (DIF) staining. All CPA dermatopathologists are experienced in the interpretation of DIF stains for immunobullous diseases, lichen planus, lupus, vasculitis, and other connective tissue diseases.
- Direct transport of specimens by CPA-employed or contracted couriers. All specimens transported to the lab are verified by manifest for maximum accountability.
